1928 – 2018



With great sadness, we learnt of the passing of Helen Revell last November.

Helen was joint founder, along with Richard Crisp, of Saxmundham Museum and Saxmundham and District Local History Society.

Before retiring, she taught domestic science at Leiston Grammar School and Leiston and Saxmundham Middle Schools.

From 1961 to 1982, her late husband, Jack, was headmaster of Saxmundham Primary School.

Helen played an enormous part in the life of Saxmundham. She was Town Recorder for many years after retirement, as well as continuing her roles as Museum Trustee, Steward and Management Committee member well into her 80s.
